


M-38A1 Willys Jeep

U.S. Service: 1952 to 1971

The M-38A1 was the last Willys jeep produced for the US military. It would become the basis for the civilian model Jeep CJ5. It is a four wheel drive, military light utility vehicle. The basic version was unarmed, unarmored and had a crew of one. Other variants adapted equipment as needed for their tasks.

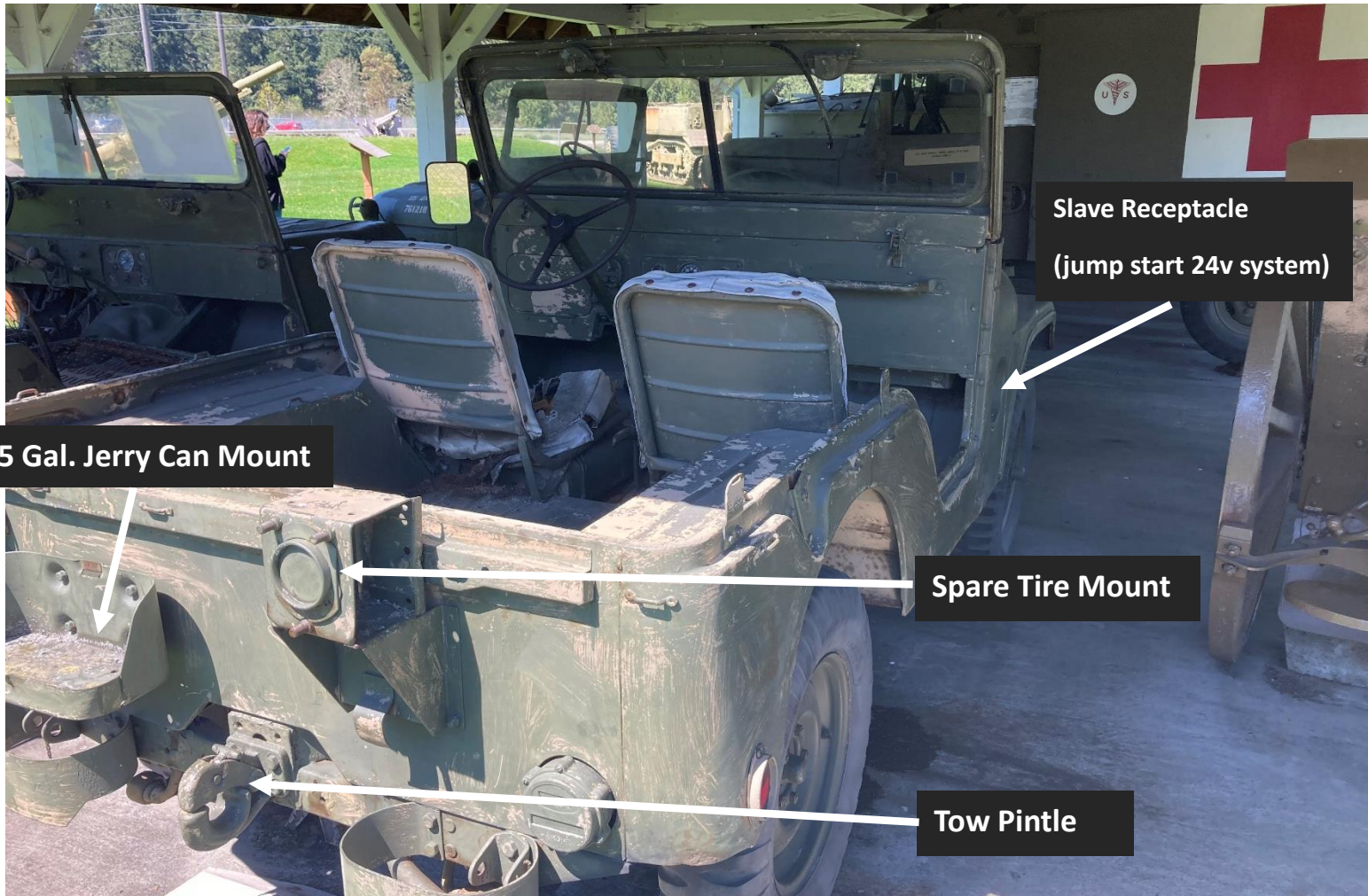
It served through the Korean and Vietnam Wars eventually being replaced by the M-151 MUTT. It would go on to serve with other countries around the world after it's retirement.

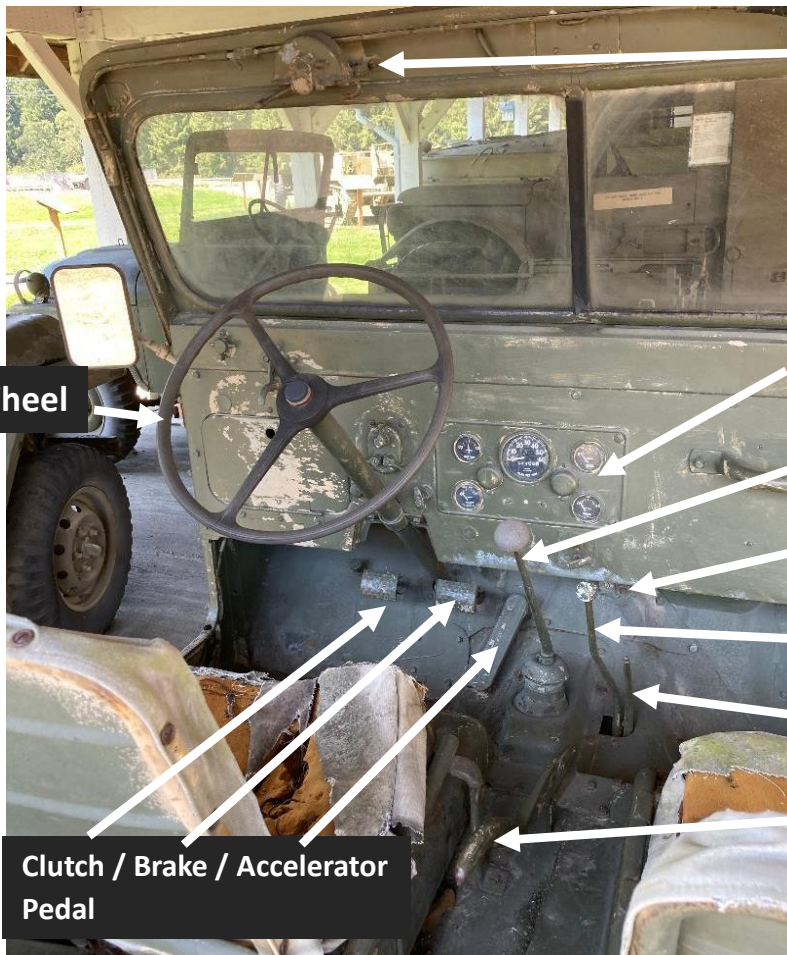
